Geography is a popular and successful subject at Woldingham. At Key Stage 3 the students study a wide variety of topics including sustainable settlements, retail, Antarctica, development, super-volcanoes and climate change. They Key Stage 3 course begins with an intensive skills programme to equip the students with the necessary tools for Geographical investigation and analysis. At ICSE we follow the Edexcel IGCSE syllabus and at A Level we study the AQA syllabus. Ourrently we run a residential trip with Year 10 for 3 days to Swanage, Dorset, and a four-day residential visit to Somerset for the A level NEA. Every couple of years, we also embark on an enrichment trip. These have included Iceland and The Azores in the recent past.

The Geography classrooms are situated together in Marden, close to one of the ICT suites. All classrooms have interactive whiteboard displays and sound systems, as well as more traditional whiteboards. The department is well resourced and is prominent within the school.
